Access Fees

As a developer awarded access rights to connect to new transmission lines in the South West Renewable Energy Zone (REZ), Origin contributes access fees to EnergyCo's Community and Employment Benefit Program.

Voluntary Planning Agreements

Origin has entered Voluntary Planning Agreements (VPAs) with the Murrumbidgee and Edward River Councils as part of the project's planning approvals process.

Each agreement includes a \$5 million contribution to support local infrastructure projects, including the construction of a new Jerilderie medical centre in Murrumbidgee Shire.

Origin looks forward to working with both councils and the communities to deliver on these important commitments.



Neighbourhood

A Neighbourhood Benefits program that provides those closest to the Yanco Delta project area with special access to a range of Origin's products and services is currently being developed.



Community Benefit

Origin has proudly supported communities across NSW through community investment programs for more than a decade. In developing the Yanco Delta Wind Farm community investment program, we will work with the local community to identify and prioritise initiatives that align with the communities' needs.



First Nations

First Nations-led investments will focus on addressing the unique challenges and opportunities faced by First Nations communities. These initiatives will be developed in collaboration with local First Nations groups and will include financial and non-financial support to promote wellbeing, self-determination, and the celebration of culture and identity.



Strategic Partnerships

Strategic partnerships are established to create long-lasting, sustainable improvements that address systemic issues and drive positive change for future generations. Preliminary engagement has commenced on potential partnership opportunities with stakeholders, including industry and business groups and universities that have interests across the broader project area.

What's next

Following a period of community consultation, the Community and First Nations Investment Programs will commence in the second half of 2025, while the Neighbourhood Benefits Program will begin when construction commences.
