

Yanco Delta Wind Farm

Shared Benefits



Yanco Delta Wind Farm is a proposed **1.5 GW wind farm** located approximately 10 km north-west of Jerilderie within the NSW South West Renewable Energy Zone. The Project was approved on 23 December 2023 and includes the construction of **up to 208 wind turbines, an 800 MW / 800 MWh BESS** and associated infrastructure, capable of generating enough renewable energy to power approximately 750,000* homes each year.

Origin is committed to ensuring communities near the Yanco Delta Wind Farm share in the long-term benefits of hosting the Project. The shared benefits program is designed to support wellbeing, local capability, First Nations recognition and regional resilience. It is informed by local communities and is separate from planning-related impact mitigation.

The program reflects community aspirations, local values and regional priorities and will evolve over the life of the Project.

What we've heard


Engagement with local communities has highlighted consistent themes shaping the Shared Benefits Program:

- The importance of fairness and transparency
- Improving local services and facilities
- Energy bill relief and energy related benefits
- Improving telecommunications reliability
- Supporting environmental management and decarbonisation
- Creating regional opportunities and long-term pathways for youth
- Strengthening community resilience.

Investment areas

The shared benefits program will deliver investment across five areas:

- **Regulatory:** Access fee contributions to EnergyCo's Community and Employment Benefit Program, plus \$10 million in up front voluntary planning agreements (VPAs) with the Murrumbidgee and Edward River Councils, including support for a medical centre in Jerilderie and a childcare centre in Deniliquin.
- **Neighbourhood:** Energy-related benefits and local priorities developed with those closest to the Project area.
- **Community Benefits:** Ongoing support for local projects and events through a Community Investment Fund.
- **First Nations:** Initiatives co-designed with First Nations groups to promote wellbeing, self-determination and cultural recognition.
- **Strategic Partnerships:** Collaboration with local industry, business groups and universities to deliver long-term regional improvements.



Program approach

Origin is working with residents, First Nations partners, councils and regional stakeholders to refine how benefits are prioritised and delivered. Engagement will continue throughout development and construction to ensure investments remain aligned with community needs.

The shared benefits program spans the Project's lifetime. Early benefits include the committed VPAs and a Community Investment Fund which will commence in 2026. Most benefits, including neighbourhood benefits, begin when construction starts.
